rally will be held indoors). The agility classes will be held outside
rain or shine.

Entry fees for a dog in all 3 events (obed, rally, agility) \$50.00
Entry fee for a dog only competing in one event \$20.00

Obedience Classes offered:

Pre Novice ---- (for dogs with no CD legs)
Exercises will be heel on leash, circles left and right, sit for exam, recall and group sit exercise as per the CKC rule book.
Scored out of 100

Novice----- (for dogs with no CDX legs)
All novice exercises as in the CKC rule book
Scored out of 100

Open----- (for dogs with no UD legs)
Scored out of 100

Utility----- (for dogs with a utility leg or better)
Scored out of 100

*Jr. Veterans Class-----
(for dogs 7 or over but under 10 on the day of event)
Exercises will be heel on leash figure 8 on leash, heel free, drop on recall, retrieve on the flat and a 3 minute DOWN stay in sight.
Scored out of 100

*Sr. Veterans Class----- (for dogs 10 and over the day of event)
Exercises will be the same as the Jr. Veterans with only a straight recall.
Scored out of 100

Brace Class----- they will do all Novice exercises.
Scored out of 100

*** Note: any dog entered in a Veterans class may not compete in any other class except the Brace class.

Rally CKC classes offered

Novice: for dogs with no legs in advanced
Scored out of 100

Advanced: for dogs with no excellent legs
Scored out of 100

Excellent: for all dogs competing in excellent even if they have the title
Scored out of 100

Agility Jumpers with weaves

Sub novice: Dogs with no titles in agility it will be a novice jumpers with weaves (only 6 weaves)
Scored out of 100

Novice: CKC novice courses for dogs with any novice legs or starters' legs but no Advanced/Intermediate legs
Scored out of 100

Intermediate: For dogs with no excellent or masters legs
Scored out of 100

Excellent: For dogs with at least excellent or masters legs
Scored out of 100

1st to 3rd place ribbons awarded for each obedience, rally and agility class and also for the overall winner of each event. Combined event scores will be added together to award the overall Versatility Winner.
